A Local Law authorizing the County Legislature to take over the maintenance of bridges having a span of twenty-two (22) feet or more.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE YATES COUNTY LEGISLATURE, as follows:

Section 1. In the County of Yates, the provisions of Section 234 of the Highway Law making it the responsibility of the county to maintain all bridges located in the county having a span of twenty-five feet or more, shall apply to all bridges located in the county having a span of twenty-two feet or more, but not including bridges on state highways.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.
