A LOCAL LAW SUPERSEDING COUNTY LAW 214 (2) REGARDING PUBLICATION OF LOCAL LAWS

Section 1. Purpose and Intent

The Yates County Legislature intends by this local law to supersede the provisions of County Law 214 (2), which requires that a true copy of each local law be published in the official news papers at least once a week for two successive weeks. In order to reduce costs, this Legislature desires that the publication of the full text of each local law be discontinued, and replaced with only that detail necessary to insure that the public remains fully informed. This local law is adopted pursuant to Article IX of the Constitution of the State of New York, as interpreted by the Attorney General in Volume 92, Informal Opinion 1 and Volume 97, Informal Opinion 12, and elsewhere.

Section 2. Publication Requirements

Upon the adoption of each local law of the County of Yates, the Clerk of the Legislature shall cause the publication once in the official newspapers of the county of the notice of the adoption of said local law and an abstract of the provisions thereof. Said notice shall include the location and availability of a copy of the actual text of each local law. This publication shall be in lieu of that required by County Law 214 (2), which is hereby expressly superseded by this local law.

Section 3.

This Local Law shall take affect immediately.
