**AUTHORIZATION OF ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER TO ISSUE AN APPEARANCE
TICKET**

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the

County

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Yates as follows:

§100-0 Purpose

- A. In order to take enforcement action and commence a case in local criminal court in securing the appearance of a defendant regarding State and local laws especially NYS Agriculture and Markets law regarding licensing, cruelty, dogs and other animal related offenses the Sheriff's Animal Control Officer requires the authority to issues an appearance ticket.
- B. That this local law shall be enacted pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.

§100-1 Definition

- A. For the purposes of this local law, "Appearance Ticket" will be exactly as defined in Section 150.10 of the New York State Criminal Procedure Law and is a written notice issued and subscribed by a police officer or other public servant authorized by state law or local law enacted pursuant to the provisions of the municipal home rule law to issue the same, directing a designated person to appear in a designated local criminal court at a designated future time in connection with his alleged commission of a designated offense. A notice conforming to such definition constitutes an appearance ticket regardless of whether it is referred to in some other provision of law as a summons or by any other name or title.
- B. For the purposes of this local law "Animal Control Officer" shall mean the person appointed by the Sheriff of Yates County designated as a non-union co-employee of the county and Sheriff for a permanent appointment from an eligible civil service list recognized as a public servant for the purposes so designated.

§100-3 Authority

- A. Resolved that the Animal Control Officer as defined before in this article is hereby vested with the enforcement power of a public servant under CPL §150.10 and 150.20 to issue an Appearance Ticket as defined before in this article to secure an appearance of a defendant in local court.

§100-4 Effective Date

- A. This Yates County local law 1-08 shall take effect upon its proper filing with the Office of the Secretary of State for New York.
