Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the**County**~~City~~ of Yates as follows:~~Town~~~~Village~~

SECTION 1. That this Local Law be enacted for the purpose of complying with the decisions of the United States Supreme Court and the Courts of this state establishing the one man one vote rule.

SECTION 2. That as of January 1, 1968, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yates shall cease to exist and be abolished.

SECTION 3. That as of January 1, 1968 a new board shall be established in the place and stead of the Board of Supervisors and shall be known as the Yates County Board. That the Yates County Board shall have all of the same powers and duties as the present Board of Supervisors and all of the powers and duties and obligations granted and imposed on the Board of Supervisors by the County Law, the General Municipal Law, the Local Finance Law, the Town Law, and all other statutory laws relating to a Board of Supervisors. The Yates County Board shall have the same offices as the now Board of Supervisors, and all of the rules and regulations and procedures heretofore adopted by the Yates County Board of Supervisors shall be continued by the Yates County Board until changed or amended by said Yates County Board.

SECTION 4. That there shall be eleven members of the Yates County Board who shall be elected to said Yates County Board by the electors of the County of Yates at the General Election to be held in November 1967.

SECTION 5. That for the purpose of electing the members to said Yates County Board, the County of Yates is hereby divided into five districts as follows: District No. 1, Towns of Torrey and Benton; District No. 2, Town of Milo; District No. 3, Towns of Jerusalem and Italy; District 4, Towns of Starkey and Barrington; District No. 5, Towns of Potter and Middlesex. Each of said districts shall elect the following number of members to said Yates County Board as hereinafter provided; District 1, two members; District No. 2, four members; District No. 3, two members; District No. 4 two members; District No. 5, one member.

SECTION 6. That the members of the Yates County Board shall be elected for a term of two years and shall be elected every two years thereafter by the electors of the County of Yates.

SECTION 7. Every member of the Yates County Board at the time of his election and throughout his term of office, shall be an elector of his district, and shall be an owner of real property in his district.

SECTION 8. There shall be continued to be elected in each Town of Yates County, a town supervisor. The town supervisor shall also be eligible to be elected as a member of the Yates County Board and to hold both offices at the same time.

SECTION 9. That as to all matters and all procedures to be voted on by the members of the Yates County Board, each member shall have one vote.

SECTION 10. That all applicable provisions of the Election Law and the Town Law which provide for the method and procedure for the nomination and election of town officers, shall apply to the nomination and election of members to the Yates County Board.

SECTION 11. This Local Law shall become effective after the same has been approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the County of Yates voting at a Special Election.

It is hereby directed that this local law shall be submitted to the vote of the qualified voters of this county at a Special Election, and pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

***Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a countywide basis or, if there are none, the chairperson of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.**

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20__ of the City of _____ having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of section (36)(37) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the (special)(general) election held on _____ 20__, became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20__ of the County of _____ State of New York, having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November _____ 20____, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
