Be it enacted by the Yates County Legislature of the**County**~~City~~ of Yates as follows:~~Town~~~~Village~~

Section 1. Legislative Intent

The purpose of this Local Law is to promote Highway Safety within Yates County by the establishment of a Traffic Safety Board.

Section 2. Legislative Authority

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Article 43 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, as amended.

Section 3. Short Title

This Local Law shall hereafter be known as the Yates County Traffic Safety Board Law.

Section 4. Traffic Safety Board Established

1. There is hereby established the Yates County Traffic Safety Board to be composed of 15 members interested in Traffic Safety and traffic problems to be appointed by at least the majority affirmative vote of the total voting power of the Yates County Legislature.
2. Each member shall be a resident of the County and a qualified elector of the County. Each member shall be appointed from the County at Large.
3. The term of office of each member shall be three years, except that the members first appointed shall be appointed as follows: five for a term of one year; five for a term of two years and five for a term of three years. Upon the expiration of the term of office of any member, his successor shall be appointed to membership for a term of three years.

4. Members shall receive no compensation for services but shall be entitled to reasonable and necessary expenses, incurred in the performance of their duties, within the appropriation made for that purpose.

5. Organization and Reports by the Traffic Safety Board

The Yates County Traffic Safety Board shall:

1. Meet and organize within fifteen days after its members are appointed.
2. Elect annually a chairman, vice-chairman and a secretary from its members.
3. Adopt rules for the conduct of its business
4. Within the limits of the appropriations made therefore by the Yates County Legislature, authorize the employment of such personnel as may be necessary to properly perform the functions and carry out the objectives of this Local Law.
5. Appoint an executive secretary who shall be the executive and administrative officer of the board.
6. Render annually to the Yates County Legislature, and from time to time as required, a verified account of all moneys received and expended by it or under its direction and an account of its proceedings and of other pertinent matters in such form and manner as may be required by such board.

Section 6. Function of the Traffic Safety Board

The Yates County Traffic Safety Board is authorized:

1. To promote and encourage street and highway traffic safety.
2. To formulate county-wide highway safety programs and coordinate efforts of interested parties and agencies engaged in traffic safety education.
3. To cooperate with local officials within the county in the formulation and execution of traffic safety programs and activities.
4. To study traffic conditions on streets and highways within the county study and analyze reports of accidents and causes thereof, and recommend to the appropriate legislative bodies, departments or commissions, such changes in rules, orders, regulations and existing law as the board may deem advisable.
5. To conduct meetings within the county whenever and wherever the Traffic Safety Board shall deem it advisable and to invite to such meetings parties and agencies, public and private, interested in traffic regulation, control and safety education.
6. To promote safety education for drivers and pedestrians.
7. To obtain and assemble motor vehicle accident data, and to analyze, study and consolidate such data for educational and informational purposes.
8. Coordinate and direct all local activities related to the implementation of the state highway safety program, as approved by the governor or his designee.

Section 7. Executive Secretary of the Traffic Safety Board

The Executive Secretary of the Traffic Safety Board shall:

1. Subject to the supervision and control of the Traffic Safety Board perform the functions necessary to properly and efficiently carry out the provisions and purposes of this Local Law.
2. Be a citizen of the United States.
3. Receive such salary and expenses as the Yates County Legislature may fix and properly account for such expenses.

4. Furnish an official undertaking in an amount and in such form and with such sureties as shall be approved by the Yates County Legislature.

Section 8. Validity

If any section, sub-section, paragraph, clause, sentence or phrase of this Local Law is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

Section 9. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect on the 20th day of April, 1973.
