A local law Prohibiting Certain Activities in the Keuka Lake Outlet Preservation Area

Section 1. Legislative Intent

The purpose of this Local Law is to prohibit certain activities by persons within the Keuka Lake Outlet Preservation Area.

Section 2. Legislative Authority

This Local Law is enacted to protect the health, safety and welfare of inhabitants of Yates County and others using the Keuka Lake Outlet Preservation Area, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Law and the County Law of the State of New York.

Section 3. Definitions

Whenever used in this Local Law, the phrase "Keuka Lake Outlet Preservation Area" or "Preservation Area" shall mean the real property conveyed by Owasco River Railway, Inc. to Yates County by Deed recorded in Yates County Clerk's Office in Liber 305 of Deeds at page 147 plus any real property owned or leased by the County of Yates and contiguous to the former Owasco River Railway, Inc. property, excluding state, county and town highways and village streets.

Section 4. Prohibition

On or within the Keuka Lake Outlet Preservation Area, no person shall:

A. Litter

B. Cut or remove trees, plants, shrubbery nor remove soil, sand, gravel or any other material except when working under the direct supervision of a Yates County official.

C. Remain upon the real property after being directed to leave by a New York State Police Officer of Yates County Deputy Sheriff or Penn Yan Village Police Officer.

D. Fail to comply with any posted regulation adopted by the Yates County Legislature.

Section 5. Violation

A violation of this Local Law shall constitute an offense and the violator shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$50.00 for each such offense.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect on the 1st day of June , 1984.
