- Section 1. The purpose of this Local Law is to offer "Gold Star Parents" whose sons or daughters were killed while serving in the United States Military during wartime, a partial exemption from real property taxes.
- Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Subdivision 7(A) of Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, a "Gold Star Parent", for purposes of this Local Law, shall mean the parent of a child who died in the line of duty while serving in the United States Armed Forces during a period of war.
- Section 3. A "Gold Star Parent" shall be included within the definition of "Qualified Owner" as provided in paragraph (c) of Subdivision One of Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York. Property owned by a "Gold Star Parent" shall be included within the definition of "Qualifying Residential Real Property" as provided in that such property shall be the primary residence of the "Gold Star Parent".
- Section 4. The additional exemption provided for in paragraph (c) of Subdivision Two of Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York shall not apply to real property owned by a "Gold Star Parent".
- Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.

This Local Law shall apply to applications made for the tax year 2001 and subsequent years with respect to the tax year 2001, the provisions here of shall apply to any such application made prior to the adoption of this local law if submitted prior to Taxable Status Day, March 1, 2001.
