Local Law No. 2 of the year 1956

A local law Authorizing The board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Yates To Appoint Deputy Commissioners Of Elections.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors ___ of the

County

SECTION 1: That, pursuant to the provisions of Section 400, Subdivision 4 of the County Law, the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to appoint two Deputy Commissioners of Elections; one of whom shall be a member of the Republican party, and the other shall be a member of the Democratic party. Said Deputy Commissioners of Elections shall act in the place and stead of a disabled or absent Commissioner of Elections, and shall have all the powers and duties of a Commissioner of Elections while so acting, and pursuant to the provisions of the Election Law. In the event of the inability to act or absence of a Commissioner of Elections who is a member of the Republican party, then the Deputy Commissioner appointed to represent the Republican party shall act for said disabled or absent Commissioner. In the event of the inability to act or absence of the Commissioner of Elections who is a member of the Democratic party, then the Deputy Commissioner appointed to represent the Democratic party shall act for said disabled or absent commissioner.

SECTION 2: The procedure for such appointment shall be the same as prescribed by the Election Law for the appointment of Commissioners.

SECTION 3: The compensation of a Deputy Commissioner of Elections, while acting in the place and stead of a Commissioner, shall be at the rate of pay established by the Board of Supervisors for temporary employees.

SECTION 4: That this Local Law shall take effect on the twentieth day after it shall have been adopted, and after a public hearing, as required by Section 304 of the County Law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Local Law shall take effect on the twentieth day after October 8, 1956.
