Emergency Management – Brian Winslow

Brian reviewed the following resolutions that would be needed. The Committee approved.

- Resolution to Appoint Members To The Yates County Fire Advisory Board
- Resolution to Accept PDMC FY 2015 Sub-Grant 001 Yates County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update FEMA Award

Brian passed around thermal cameras that he purchased through a grant for the fire departments, the Sheriff's Department and the Police Department.

Brian reported on meetings and trainings he attended.

Sheriff – Ron Spike

Ron reviewed a position review form for a Correction Officer vacancy due to a retirement, along with other staffing issues as well. The consensus of the Committee was to move forward with filling position. Ron gave an update on the Chief Correction Officer position and the interview panel make-up.

Ron reported on the jail population. There are 33 Yates County, and 12 Federal for a total of 44. Of those there are 41 males and 3 females.

Ron reviewed the revenue report.

Ron reported there was another issue with an overhead door at that Jail. Building and Grounds now has the door fixed but due to the age it is getting difficult to find parts.

Ron reported the Commission of Correction is concerned about the Law Library in the jail. They have advised the Sheriff that library needs to be updated. Ron is looking into options. One would be to go with West Law online which you have to subscribe to which will cost \$3,600 a year. The Sheriff is mandated to have a law library for the inmates use.

Ron reviewed highlights for the month of January, Fraud/Bad Chk/Welfare fraud 24 cases, Vehicle & Traffic UTT's 120 issued, and Dog's redeemed by owner 6.

Ron reported on the fiber connections to the Sherman Hill and Angus towers. ECC should be all set to hook the fiber to the radio gateway system for the towers. This should be taking place this week. If testing goes well Ron is considering changing the primary connection to fiber and use the microwave as a backup.

Ron recently spoke on Slow Moving Vehicles at the NYS-GTSC symposium in East Syracuse and he shared his power point presentation on "Sharing the Road with SMV's" and safety issues with committee.
