County~~City~~ of Yates~~Town~~~~Village~~**Local Law No. 3 of the year 1971.****A local law to provide for Reapportionment of the County of Yates.**

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the**County**~~City~~ of Yates as follows:~~Town~~~~Village~~

1. That as of January 1, 1972 the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yates shall cease to exist and be abolished.
2. That as of January 1, 1972, a new board shall be established in place and stead of the Board of Supervisors and shall be known as the Legislative Board of the County of Yates. That the Legislative Board of the County of Yates shall have all the same powers and duties as the present Board of Supervisors and all the powers and duties and obligations granted and imposed on the Board of Supervisors by the County Law, the General Municipal Law, the Local Finance Law, the Town Law and all other statutory laws relating to a Board of Supervisors. The Legislative Board of the County of Yates shall have the same offices as the now Board of Supervisors, and all of the rules and regulations and procedures adopted by the Legislative Board of the County Yates until changed or amended by said Legislative Board of the County of Yates.
3. That there shall be thirteen (13) members of the Legislative Board of the County of Yates who shall be elected to said Legislative Board by the electors of the County of Yates at the general election to be held in November 1971.
4. That for the purpose of electing the members of said Legislative Board, the County of Yates is hereby divided into five (5) election districts as follows:

District No. 1: Towns of Italy and Middlesex

District No. 2: Towns of Benton, Potter, and Torrey

District No. 3: Town of Jerusalem

District No. 4: Election districts numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6 of the Town of Milo

District No. 5: Towns of Barrington and Starkey and election district number 7 of the Town of Milo

5. Each of the said five (5) districts shall elect the following number of members to said Legislative Board of the County of Yates, as hereinafter provided:

District No. 1: One member
District No. 2: Three members
District No. 3: Two members
District No. 4: Four members
District No. 5: Three members

6. Each member of the Legislative Board of the County of Yates shall have one vote in respect to all procedures to be voted on by the members of the Legislative Board of the County of Yates.
7. That the members of the Legislative Board of Yates County shall be elected for a term of two (2) years thereafter by the electors of the County of Yates.
8. Every member of the Legislative Board of Yates County shall, at the time of his election and throughout his term of office, be an elector of his district.
9. The Town Supervisor of any town in Yates County and the Mayor of any incorporated Village in Yates County shall be eligible to be elected as a member of the Legislative Board of the County of Yates.
10. That as to all matters and all procedures to be voted on by the members of the Legislative Board of the County of Yates, each member shall have one vote.
11. That all applicable provisions of the Election Law which provides for the method and procedure for the nomination and election for county officers, shall apply to the Legislative Board of the County of Yates and further, that each member shall be nominated and elected in the respective district which he would represent if elected.

***Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a countywide basis or, if there are none, the chairperson of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.**

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20__ of the County of _____ State of New York, having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November _____ 20____, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
