Section 1. Legislative Intent

The purpose of this local law is to legalize the adoption by the Town of Barrington, Yates County, New York of Town of Barrington Local Law No. 2-1976 duly passed by the Barrington Town Board on August 30, 1976. A petition requesting this legalizing act was filed with the Yates County Legislature on September 13, 1976; a resolution was adopted by the Yates County Legislature on that date directing the holding of a public hearing in the Town Hall in the Town of Barrington, Yates County, New York on September 30, 1976 on the question of legalizing said local law; that said hearing was held and a report of the results of said hearing filed with this Legislature, that the omission intended to be corrected by this local law was the failure of the Town Board of the Town of Barrington to give public notice of and hold a public hearing on the question of adopting said local law prior to the adoption thereto; that the report of the public hearing held by this Legislature in Town of Barrington shows that the omission to publish and hold a public hearing was not the result of fraud and that no substantial hardship will result to the residence of the Town of Barrington, Yates County, New York from such omission.

Section 2. Legislative Authority

This local law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Section 227 of the County Law of the State of New York.

Section 3. Short Title

This local law shall hereafter be known as Yates County Local Law legalizing Local Law No. 2-1976 of the Town of Barrington, Yates County, New York".

Section 4. Legislative Determination.

The Yates County Legislature hereby legalizes and validates the Town of Barrington Local Law No. 2-1976 entitled "Town of Barrington Freshwater Wetlands Protection Law". The text of which law is as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

The purpose of this local law is to provide for regulation of

freshwater wetlands in the Town of Barrington, Yates County, New York.

Section 2. Legislative Authority

This local law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Article 24 of the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York.

Section 3. Short Title

This local law shall hereafter be known as the Town of Barrington Freshwater Wetlands Protection Law.

Section 4. Regulatory Authority

Pursuant to Section 24-0501 of Article 24 of the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York, being New York State Freshwater Wetlands Act., the Town of Barrington shall fully undertake and exercise its regulatory authority with regard to activities subject to regulation under the Act in freshwater wetlands, as shown on the Freshwater Wetlands Map, as such map may from time to time be amended, filed by the Department of Environmental Conservation pursuant to the Act, and in all areas adjacent to any such freshwater wetland up to 100 feet from the boundary of such wetland. Such regulatory authority shall be undertaken and exercised in accordance with all of the procedures, concepts and definitions set forth in Article 24 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law and Title 23 of Article 71 of such law relating to the enforcement of Article 24, as such law may from time to time be amended, with such exceptions, additions and modifications as may hereafter be adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Barrington pursuant to and consistent with the laws of the State of New York.

Section 5. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect upon filing and publication as required by Law and be implemented in accordance with Title 5 of Article 24 of Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York.

This local law shall take effect upon filing and publication as required by law.
