A. Section 2 is amended to provide as follows:

SECTION 2. COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR: APPOINTMENT: TERM.

On or after January 1, 1988 there shall be a County Administrator, who shall be appointed by the County Legislature for a term ending December 31, 1990. Thereafter, the County Administrator shall be appointed for a two year term. The County Administrator will be appointed for a one year term ending December 30, 1993, and a one year term ending December 31, 1994. Thereafter, the County Administrator shall be appointed for a two year term ending December 31, 1996. Thereafter, the County Administrator shall be appointed for a four year term. The County Administrator shall be directly responsible to and serve at the pleasure of the County Legislature and shall be a person qualified by formal training in public administration, finance, or related fields, and by experience in an administrative executive position in governmental administration or by equivalent experience and training sufficient to indicate capacity for effective governmental administration. He/she shall be a resident of the county during his/her tenure of office.
