The Yates County Legislature convened in special session, Tuesday, July 7, 2015 with Chairman Dennis presiding and Legislators Montgomery and Holgate absent.

RESOLUTION NO. 220-15

Mr. Morris offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Mrs. Percy.

**APPOINT PERSONNEL OFFICER
(Brennan)**

RESOLVED, that effective July 13, 2015 Kerry Brennan is hereby appointed as Personnel Officer for a term to expire on May 31, 2018, and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be given to Kerry Brennan, the County Administrator and the Treasurer.
