RECYCLING – Connie Hayes

Connie reviewed her memo regarding participating in the Household Hazardous Waste Day next year with Schuyler County along with reviewing the State Grant for E-Waste.

Connie explained that she has put \$2,500 in the 2017 budget to participate with Schuyler County on a Household Hazardous Waste Day. In speaking with Schuyler County this morning, that figure may need to be increased. Connie will have better figures at budget workshop.

The consensus of the Committee was to not apply for the E-Waste Grant at this time because the county will not be reimbursed for the electronics that the public would be recycling.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT – Dave Hartman

Dave reviewed his proposed 2017 budget.

Dave reported the capital road projects are done, and they are working on maintenance projects.

Dave reported the Vine Valley Bridge is almost complete. The Alexander Road Bridge work is progressing. There will be a resolution Monday to amend the resolution for engineering services on the Alexander Road. Dave updated the Committee on the status of various bridges in the County.

Dave reported there is a possibility that Highway may be able to get a track excavator through an equipment grant. Dave will report more as information becomes available.

BUILDINGS & GROUNDS - Joe Reed

Joe reviewed his proposed 2017 budget.

Joe reviewed the Weights & Measures report.

Joe reported he is still working on solar installation and will meet with the Administrator and County Attorney and report more next month.

Joe reported work has begun on the Public Health Clinic, documents are being finalized for submittal to the state.
